Guild Booth Participation

- <u>Booth Options</u> Please let us know on the application sheet which of the following options you want for your guild booth this year: Flyers only on a community table, one table and pole set for an unmanned booth, up to two tables and pole sets for a manned booth.
- **<u>Demos</u>** of small projects and giveaways are encouraged.
- **Ouilts for your guild display**

One eight-foot metal pole structure will be provided, giving you hanging space to display your quilts. You will need to provide a backdrop for the pole structure (e.g. dark color queen size sheets). One six-foot table will also be provided for your guild displays. This year's QDO theme is "Two-Color Quilt", if you wish to incorporate it into your display.

- <u>Display a large sign</u> with the name of your guild in a visible area of your booth and provide a handout giving your guild's detailed information.
- **Best Guild Booth Award** will be given by Viewers' Choice vote and the winning guild will receive an award for future display.

Door Prize Basket

Each guild is asked to provide a Door Prize Basket. Quilt related items are suggested. The total value should be at least \$50.00. A ticket container for the drawing will be provided for each guild at the Door Prize Table. See enclosed for additional information. The Grand Prize this year has a Get Organized theme, valued from \$350 to \$500.

Guild Door Prize Tickets

Attendees will receive one free Door Prize Ticket to drop in the Grand Prize Ticket Box or Guild Door Prize Ticket Box for the basket of their choice when the \$6 entrance fee is paid. Additional Door Prize Tickets will be available for purchase for \$1.00 each at the ends of the Guild Door Prize Table. These tickets are to be used for the Grand Prize or Guild Door Prizes only - not Vendor Door Prizes!!!

Vendors

There will be vendors on site for attendees' shopping pleasure. Vendors may provide door prizes and tickets for their door prizes at their booths. The vendor door prize tickets are to be deposited at the vendor's booth.

Announcements for all Prizes will be made throughout the facility. You must be present to win any of the Prizes, but you have thirty minutes after the announcement to claim your prize, so feel free to continue your activities during Prize Drawing Times.

Attendees are encouraged to enter a quilt into the QDO quilt challenge. This year's theme is "**Two-Color Quilt.**" The challenge application is due no later than Friday, January 25, 2019, but the quilt does not have to be finished until February 22, 2019. The quilt challenge information and application form is included in this information packet.

- The Guild Booth application is due no later than Friday, January 25, 2019.
- Admission is \$6.00 and a donation for our chosen charity.
- Short Demonstrations will be provided in the Vendor Room.
- Guild Booth set-up: Friday, February 22, from 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. or Saturday, February 23, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. All booths **MUST** be ready by 8:00 a.m. on Saturday morning.
- A breakfast/lunch café will be available on site in the vendor room area. Breakfast from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00, lunch from 10:00 to 2:00 p.m. The Conference Centre does not allow outside food to be brought in, so we request attendees not bring a brown bag lunch.
- As a courtesy to our vendors, purchases and preview shopping will not be allowed before 9:00 a.m.
