

# Challenge Entry Information and Guidelines

Quilters' Day Out, February 25, 2017

Divisions:

**Old to New** (represent previously designed or cut items in recently made quilt)

Quilt that is made from items initially created and unfinished dating prior to 1990. Quilt squares, cross stitch, crochet, etc. made into a quilt. Quilt can be any size but no larger than 90 inches by 108 inches.

**Memory** (depict a family or historical event)

Quilt that shows or represents a memory of historical significance to the quilter. The quilt can use any technique, i.e. tee-shirt, pictorial, etc. The quilt should come with a story describing the memory the quilt represents. Quilt can be any size but no larger than 90 inches by 108 inches.

**Traditional** (historically represent early American quilting)

Quilt that looks like those made from the 1800s through the 1950s. The quilt can be made from any era reproduction fabric, flannel, clothing, etc. Quilt can be any size but no larger than 90 inches by 108 inches.

## **Challenge Committee has the right to change the division if deemed necessary.**

1. The Entry Form must be received either by email or postmarked by USPS by January 25, 2017. No late entries will be accepted.
2. All quilts must be clean, smoke free, pet hair and odor free, and constructed of fabric. Must consist of three layers: top, batting and backing and must be quilted in some fashion.
3. Quilt must have an identifying label on the back. That label must contain your name, your city and state, the name of your quilt and the month and year finished. Must be attached on the back in the bottom Right Corner as you look at the quilt.
4. Only **one quilt entry per person.**
5. A confirmation email will be sent to you upon acceptance of your entry form. Any entry form received without an email address will receive a phone call as an acceptance. 6. All quilts must be received between 1:00 pm and 5:30 pm on Friday, February 24, 2017, at the Paroquet Springs Conference Centre in Shepherdsville. No quilts will be accepted day of show.
7. All quilts can be **picked up no earlier than 3:15 p.m.** following the close of the Quilters' Day Out. After the show has ended, your completed entry form and a picture ID must be presented to pick up your quilt. If your quilt will be picked up by someone else, you must include the name and phone number of the person picking up your quilt in your submission email or envelope. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
